Regional Development Australia Adelaide Hills, Fleurieu and Kangaroo Island (RDA AHFKI) has their Inspired Leadership 2023 program officially underway and will run until October, culminating in attendance at the Newday Leadership Summit at the Adelaide Convention Centre on November 2.

The first session of the program opened in Port Elliot / Kandjeinwald, on Thursday, June 1, with a Welcome to Country and coastal culture walk led by Cedric Varcoe, proud Ramindjeri man of the Ngarrindjeri Nation and son Risho.

Cedric grounded all participants in a session entitled 'How might we better know Country and know ourselves?', sharing rich stories and wisdom with the group and some of the RDA AHFKI leadership team.

Inspired Leadership 2023, delivered by Newday Leadership, is a contemporary program that celebrates excellence in the region, exploring challenges and opportunities with a global perspective.
