Each monthly session will be held in a different location, with a mid-program 'mini summit' including an overnight option. Inspired Leadership 2023 will culminate in a day at the Newday Leadership Summit in early November at the Adelaide Convention Centre.

Inspired Leadership 2023 will focus on exemplary participant experiences that appeal to all the senses (including a sense of fun, excitement and humour).

People can expect a program that will: • be connected to Country, informed by First Nations' leaders • increase leadership capacity, influence and resilience • support cross-sector collaboration • develop leadership skills • build a culture of active citizenship.

Inspired Leadership 2023 will be designed and curated Working in partnership with RDA to support the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (also known as the Global Goals). Applicants must work, volunteer or Indigenous people, know part of the region as home Country.

People aged 18 and over are encouraged to apply. A total of 15 places are available in this year's cohort, valued at more than \$6500.

Thanks to funding provided by Primary Industry and Resources South Australia these places are almost fully funded, with participants (or their organisation or employer) only required to pay \$700 (including GST). A limited number of bursaries are also available.

Applications close at midnight on April 12, with participants notified of the outcome on April 21. The program opens on May 18.
