

Leadership program positions

Regional Development Australia Hills Fleurieu KI, in partnership with the Newday Leadership organisation, is seeking expressions of interest for its inaugural regional leadership program.

Inspired Leadership 2023 is designed to align with the UN's Sustainable Development Goals and is open to those who either work, volunteer or live in the region – or for First Nations people, those who know part of the region as home Country.

There are 15 places available in this year's cohort, with Primary Industry and Resources SA (PIRSA) providing funding that will subsidise places in the six-month program.

The program aims to attract aspiring, emerging and established leaders with

a global perspective. Participants will be able to expand their leadership capabilities with the aid of specialised facilitators.

Sessions will be held once a month throughout the region, with a 'mini-summit' to be held mid-program.

RDA Hills Fleurieu KI chief executive Damien Cooke, said his team was excited to help develop future leaders.

"If you have aspirations to be a leader or want to step up even further as a leader, this program will develop your skills and significantly boost your confidence to contribute to the growth and prosperity of our region," he said.
