- being connected to Country, informed by First Nations' leaders,
- increasing leadership capacity, influence and resilience.
- · supporting cross-sector collaboration,
- · developing leadership skills,
- · building a culture of active citizenship.

Each monthly session will be held in a different location, with a mid-program 'mini summit' including an overnight option.

The program will culminate in a day at the Newday Leadership Summit in early November at the Adelaide Convention Centre.

People aged 18 and over are encouraged to apply.

Applicants must work, volunteer or live in the region or, in the case of Indigenous people, know part of the region as home Country.

A total of 15 places are available in this year's cohort with a limited number of bursaries available.

Applications close: midnight, Wednesday, April 12, with participants notified of the outcome April 21.
