Expressions of interest open for leadership program

Regional Development Australia – Adelaide Hills, Fleurieu and Kangaroo Island (RDA AHFKI) has introduced an inaugural regional leadership program for the Adelaide Hills, Fleurieu Peninsula and Kangaroo Island.

Working in partnership with RDA AHFKI, Inspired Leadership 2023 is an engaging six-month program that will support the development of regenerative leadership capability for a diverse cohort of aspiring, emerging and established leaders.

Inspired Leadership 2023 is delivered by Newday Leadership in a variety of locations across the region, on the lands of the Ngarrindjeri, Kaurna and Peramangk peoples. The program will be facilitated by Newday's co-directors Katrina Webb and Matthew Wright-Simon, and a range of specialised leadership facilitators.

This program will celebrate excellence in the region, exploring challenges and opportunities with a global perspective.

Each monthly session will be held in a different location, with a mid-program 'mini summit' including an overnight option.

People can expect a program that will:

 Be connected to Country, informed by First Nations' leaders increase leadership capacity, influence and resilience support cross-sector collaboration.

• Develop leadership skills.

• Build a culture of active citizenship.

Inspired Leadership 2023 will be designed and curated to support the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (also known as the Global Goals).

Applicants must work, volunteer or live in the region or, in the case of Indigenous people, know part of the region as home Country.

People aged 18 and over are encouraged to apply. A total of 15 places are available in this year's cohort, valued at more than \$6500.

Applications close at midnight on April 12, with participants notified of the outcome on April 21. The program opens on May 18, 2023.
